

10.1 Patent



COURSEWARE

 A patent gives an inventor or researcher exclusive rights to a product and prohibits others from making, using, or selling the product for a certain number of years

10.1 Copyright

 a form of protection provided to the authors of "original works of authorship" including literary, dramatic, musical, artistic, and certain other intellectual works, both published and unpublished.






10.3 Trademark





• is a word, name, symbol or device which is used in trade with goods to indicate the source of the goods and to distinguish them from the goods of others.

10.4 License

- means to give permission.
- the practice of leasing a legally protected property (such as a trademarked or copyrighted name, logo, likeness, character, phrase or design) to another party in conjunction with a product, service or promotion.
