#### Adjectives

Describe nouns or pronouns (things or people)
Usually go before the word they describe

We watched an old movie.

Some nouns can function as an adjective

A gold necklace a Literature book

French toast



### Adjective order

When using more than one adjective: Start with adjectives that give an opinion or impression:

A strange old silver ring

A pretty small yellow butterfly



## Followed by adjectives that give factual information, in this order.
