Adverb – say more about a verb, an adjective or another verb.

The baby is sleeping **peacefully**.

She speaks **fluently**.

Tells you... **how (manner), when (time), where (place) or how often (frequency)**

He is arriving **next week**, so we're meeting him **at the bus terminal**

Adjectives and adverbs with the same form:

Early, late, hard, loud , fast, daily, hard, low,
right,wrong, weekly, monthly

Adjectives	Adverbs
