Aim

Speed Reading: Skimming

Readers read a reading text in a very fast manner in order to look for the main ideas.







What is MAIN IDEA?

MAIN IDEAS introduce the <u>focus</u> of a reading text.

It is also called TOPIC SENTENCES.





What is TOPIC SENTENCE?

TOPIC SENTENCE introduces the focus of each paragraph in a reading text.

It can be found in the beginning, middle or at the end of a paragraph.





Steps to skim a reading text:

Preview the reading text.

Read the first and the last paragraph.

Look for the main ideas or topic sentences.

Search for keywords or repeated words
