### PARTS OF SPEECH

- 1) Nouns Name of location, individual, item or idea.
- 2) VerbThe act of performing a physical activity.Show state of being.
- 3) Preposition Designates place, time or position.
- 4) Conjunctions
  Combine words or phrases in sentences.



#### PARTS OF SPEECH

- 5) AdjectivesDescribe nouns or pronouns.
- 6) Adverb Describe verb, adjective or other adverb.
- 7) Pronoun Replace nouns.
- 8) Interjection Explain any strong emotions.
