DEFINITION OF IBADAH



REALITY OF IBADAH

 The reality of ibadah is the submission and humility of the element of soul (roh) towards its God with the feeling of being flawed in front of its God, submission towards Him, loyal towards His orders and does not breach the borders He set. <u>The</u> <u>external actions by a person in the context of</u> <u>Ibadah are merely translation or reaction shown by</u> <u>the soul / roh.</u>

ROLE OF IBADAH

- Complement one's perfection of Tauhid (The requirement towards one's perfection of Tauhid includes Tauhid Uluhiyah)
- Purification of soul through worshipping and glorifying Allah.
- Purification of actions from evil and sins.

DIVISION OF IBADAH

- Specific Ibadah : Specific Ibadah refers to ibadah where the commandments, requirements and methods of performing are explained in detail through al Quran and Hadith.
 Examples are, solat, fasting, zakat, hajj and many more.
- General Ibadah : General Ibadah refers to daily activities of a muslim except Specific Ibadah which fulfill the requirements below:
 - Sincere / With good intention.
 - Fulfilling the syariat of Islam / Do not oppose the syariat of Islam.
 - Do not cause negligence from performing fardhu practices.
