#### **MALAYSIA FOREIGN POLICY**

- All countries in this world have to interact in a two way relationship with one another.

- OIC is an international organization founded in 1969.
- OIC stands for Organization of Islamic Country.
- Since its formation, its members extended to 57 state members.
- Function to safeguard and protect the interests of Muslim around the world.



### COMMONWEATLH

- COMMONWEALTH is an international organization which its members are former territories of British empire.
- Commonwealth has 52 member states
- Commonwealth shares history, culture, language, democracy and also promote Commonwelth Games.





- Is a group of states that are not aligned or against any power block.
- It has 120 members.
- Purpose to safeguard the sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity and also struggle against the colonialism and imperialism.



## THE UNITED NATION

- Is an intergovernmental organization to promote international organization.
- There are now 193 members including Malaysia.
- The headquarters is in Manhattan, New York City.
- Purpose maintaining international peace and security, fostering economic and social development.
