

Risk Categories – Hazard Risks





Risk Categories – Control Risks

Associated with the management of uncertainty

Eg: Losses caused by fraud, potential for legal noncompliance Cause doubt on the ability to achieve organization's mission



Risk Categories – Opportunity Risks

Risks that are purposely pursued by the organization

Associated with the management of uncertain opportunities

Organization seeking to increase the achievement of the work

May affect the organization if the result is bad
