Articulo /Article

- En Español, have 2 articles.
- Article Definite (Articulo Definido) and Article Indefinite (Articulo Indefinido)
- Articulo Definido is *the*
- Articulo Indefinido is *a,an,some*

Articulo Definido (The)

Articulo Definido (The)

el (m/s) - los (m/p)

la (f/s) - las (f/p)

= *m (masculine)* *f (feminine)*

s (singular) *p (plural)*

Ejemplo : el libro -----> los libros

la silla -----> las sillas

Articulo Definido (The)

Nouns end in vowel -----> add "s"

Ejemplo : el chico -----> los chicos
la pizarra -----> las pizarras

Nouns ending in consonant -----> add "es"

Ejemplo : el papel -----> los papales
el reloj -----> los relojes

Articulo Definido (The)

Nouns ending in a “z” -----> change to “c” add “es”

Ejemplo : el lapiz -----> los lapices
 la luz -----> las luces

Nouns ending in í and ú -----> add “és”

Ejemplo : el bambú -----> los bambués

Articulo Indefinido (a,an,some)

Articulo Indefinido (a,an,some)

un (m/s) - unos (f/p)

una (f/s) - unas (f/p)

Ejemplo : un anillo -----> unos anillos

una casa -----> unas casas
