|---------------|------------------|
| Yo            | Nosotros/as      |
| tú            | Vosotros/as      |
| él/ella/usted | ellos/as/ustedes |

# The form the present tense:

(er)

-o	-emos
-es	-eis
-e	-en

# Beber (to drink)

<u>Subject Pronoun</u>	<u>verb stem</u>	<u>ending</u>	<u>conjugated</u>
Yo	beb-	o	bebo
Tu	beb-	es	bebes
Él/ella/ud	beb-	e	bebe
Nosotros/as	beb-	emos	bebemos
Vosotros/as	beb-	eis	bebeis
Ellos/as/uds	beb-	en	beben

# Example

1. Yo **leo** el libro en mi casa
2. Ella **bebe** agua
3. Nosotros **comemos** las manzanas
4. Él **ve** la televisión en su casa
