(ir)

-o	-imos
-es	-is
-e	-en

Abrir (to open)

<u>Subject Pronoun</u>	<u>verb stem</u>	<u>ending</u>	<u>conjugated</u>
Yo	abr-	o	abro
Tu	abr-	es	abres
Él/ella/ud	abr-	e	abre
Nosotros/as	abr-	imos	abrimos
Vosotros/as	abr-	is	abris
Ellos/as/uds	abr-	en	abren

2. Ella **abre** la ventana cada mañana
3. Nosotros **escribimos** la tarea
4. Él **recibo** el dinero de su padres
