In-house vs outsource

<u>Working capital</u> Does it make sense to produce own raw materials?	Business Innovation Internal resources may be trap into their own business thus limits their creativity and innovation.	<u>Risk</u> Which types of sourcing exposed business to risk?
<u>Control</u> Does control over business easier to be conducted with in- house or outsource?	<u>Location</u> Company need to consider the location of the suppliers when outsourcing	<u>Expertise</u> Company needs to consider whether they are willing to hire expert in particular operations or simply outsource.

Why Single Sourcing?

Better price offered if buying in larger quantity	To avoid inconsistency in terms of product quality	Lower costs related to source, process and inspect
Streamline the procedure	Build stronger and longer-term relationships with supplier	Reduce inventory and lead time

What is 3PL and 4PL

3PL

- Provide the services of SC management functions
- Accumulates resources, capabilities and technologies for complete SC
- Focusses on niche areas
- Target a broad array including 3PL
- Includes warehousing and transportation activities

4PL

- Include SC planning, management, assistance, designing and optimizing
- Collaborate between in-house and outsourced activities
- All activities are outsourced
- Suitable to organizations on which needs to execute certain SC process
- Suitable to organization which needs beginning to end SC operations
